SECTION II – TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER

1. Tenders are to be uploaded on e-tendering portal www.tenderwizard.com/BNP only in Two-part bid system.
2. i) **Part-I – Prequalification Bid & Techno-commercial Bid:** Scanned copy of documents pertaining to compliance of eligibility criteria (i.e order/contract and corresponding documentary evidence of completion), Technical offer (catalogue/brochure etc.), Certificate of Incorporation/Partnership Deed etc(as applicable), GST, PAN, Bank details etc., along with all sections & annexures of this tender.
ii) **Part II – Price Bid:**
Price shall be furnished through e-portal only. Price offer submitted in any other format will be liable for rejection.
3. **Payment terms:**
 - a) 100% amount of the order value shall be released within 30 days on completion of work as per order by the successful bidder at BNPM, Mysuru and on production of all required documents by the successful bidder.
 - b) Payment will be made only if the supplied consignment meets the specifications & quality criteria mentioned in the Technical Specifications.
4. **Completion Schedule:** Successful bidder shall complete the entire scope of work within three months from the date of issuance Order.
5. **Liquidated Damages:** In case your quotation is accepted and order is placed on you, the entire work against the order should be completed within the period stipulated in the order. BNPM reserves the right to recover any loss sustained due to delayed completion of work by way of LD. Failure to complete the work within the stipulated period shall entitle BNPM to impose liquidated damages without assigning any reasons @ 0.5% (Half Percent) of the total value of the item covered in order as LD per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% (Ten Percent) which you unconditionally and expressly agree to unless extension is obtained from BNPM without imposition of LD, without price escalation along with any other denial conditions (if applicable) on valid ground before expiry of completion period.
6. **Warranty:** The successful bidder warrants that the goods supplied and works carried out (as applicable) under the contract is new, unused and shall have no defect arising from design, materials (except when the design adopted and / or the material used are as per BNPM's specifications) or workmanship or from any act or omission of the successful bidder, that may develop under normal use of the supplied goods under the conditions prevailing in India. This warranty shall remain valid for Twelve (12) Months after the successful completion of the entire work as the final destination (onsite, BNPM, Mysore) and duly certified and accepted by BNPM. In case of any claim arising out of this warranty, BNPM shall promptly notify the same in writing to the successful bidder and within a mutually agreed time successful bidder shall carry out the repair and replacement work, free of cost, at the ultimate destination (i.e., onsite, BNPM, Mysore). Warranty includes minor repairs/replacement, thereafter as & when required basis.
7. **Performance Security:** - Performance security has to be submitted by the successful bidder within 21 days from the date of issue of order, whichever is earlier, for **10% (Ten percent) of the contract value** valid up to sixty days after the date of completion of all contractual obligations by the successful bidder, including the warranty obligations.

The Performance security shall be denominated in Indian Rupees or in the currency of the contract and shall be in one of the following forms:

- a. Account Payee Demand Draft drawn on any commercial bank in India, in favour Bank Note Paper Mill India Private Limited payable at Mysuru.
- b. Paper Bank Guarantee / e-Bank Guarantee issued by a scheduled commercial bank in India, in the prescribed format as provided in this document. BG issued by overseas branch of Indian Commercial Bank will not be accepted.
- c. Insurance Surety Bonds.
- d. Fixed Deposit Receipt (lien to BNPM) from a scheduled commercial bank in India.
- e. Direct wire transfer in acceptable form.

In the event of any loss due to successful bidder's failure to fulfil its obligations in terms of the contract, the amount of the performance security shall be payable to BNPM to compensate BNPM for the same.

8. Manufacturer's name and country of origin of materials offered must be clearly specified. Please quote whether your organization is large scale industry or small-scale industry. If you are registered with Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME), please attach UDYAM certificate to the quotation and mention your registration details at appropriate place provided in this tender document.
9. Complete details and IS specifications for the offered product must accompany the quotation. Make/brand of the item shall be stated wherever applicable. If you have got any deviation to the material against tender specification, the same may be shown separately at appropriate place provided in this tender document. Acceptance of deviation shall be at sole discretion of BNPM.
10. All supplies are subject to inspection and approval before acceptance. Manufacturer/ successful bidder warranty certificates and manufacturer/Government approved lab test certificate (if applicable) shall be furnished along with the supply, wherever applicable.
11. The prices quoted should be firm till the entire work is completed. Please quote the rates in words and figures. Rates quoted should be at destination (BNPM, Mysore) basis including all charges including P&F, Freight, Transit insurance, fooding, lodging, transportation etc as required to complete the work, otherwise the quotation is likely to be rejected. Price quoted should be net and valid for a minimum period of four months from the date of opening of the quotation including corrigenda (if any issued).
12. **Evaluation Criteria:**
 - (i) The technical bids shall be opened in the first instance and these bids shall be scrutinized and evaluated by the competent committee/ authority with reference to the eligibility criteria and other parameters prescribed in the tender document. Subsequently, in the second stage the financial bids of only technically acceptable offers as decided in first stage shall be opened for further scrutiny and evaluation. Intimation regarding opening of financial bids shall be given to acceptable tenderers to enable them to attend the financial bid opening, if they so desire.
 - (ii) **Method of Evaluation:** Evaluation shall be carried out on **overall effective price** quoted by the bidders, and contract shall be awarded to **overall lowest (L-1) bidder**. The quoted price should be inclusive of P&F, Freight, Transit Insurance, fooding, lodging, transportation and any other charges required for completing the work at BNPM, Mysuru on F.O.R basis.
 - (iii) **Price Tie:** After application of purchase preference (against claim of purchase preference

substantiated with documentary evidence by bidder) as applicable in accordance with PPPMSE order & in line with the corresponding evaluation guideline provided by DOE, MOF, GOI; if it is observed that there is a price tie among the bidders then the L1 bidder shall be awarded based on date of incorporation of company. CIN for Ltd or Pvt Ltd company, for proprietorship & partnership firms, date of registration & execution of partnership agreement, on non -availability of the above, GST registration date shall be considered as date of incorporation.

- (iv) All responsive tenderers shall be evaluated as per the terms & conditions of the tender. The basis for arriving at the lowest responsive bidder shall be as per the price quoted for landed cost at Mysuru including GST, packing & forwarding charges, freight, insurance, fooding, lodging, transportation and any other charges etc. and input credit shall be deducted to arrive at the effective price. Effective price shall be considered for arriving the lowest responsive bidder.
- (v) Bidder has to mention appropriate HSN/SAC code and quote GST rate provided in Price Schedule. In case of any mismatch in HSN/SAC code with respect to offered product/work, same shall be decided in consultation with winning (successful) bidder.
- (vi) All tenderers should be registered under GST. They should be eligible to pass on input credit. Bid will be evaluated all-inclusive though input credit will be deducted to arrive at the effective cost.

*If the tenderer is unregistered, the GST shall be payable by the purchaser under reverse charge and shall be added to the quoted rate to arrive at the Gross price and input credit, if any shall be deducted from the total landed cost to arrive at the net comparable price. If no indication regarding GST is recorded in the quotation, the GST will be considered as included.

- 13. Payment of GST is primarily the responsibility of the seller and will not be paid unless the percentage value is clearly mentioned in the quotations. If no indication regarding GST is recorded in the quotation, the GST will be considered as included.
- 14. **Delay in successful bidder's performance:** Time for and the date specified in the contract or as extended for the completion of the work shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and the successful bidder shall complete the work under the contract within the time schedule specified by BNPM in the contract.

Any delay attributable to the successful bidder in maintaining its contractual obligations towards delivery of goods and performance of services shall render the successful bidder liable to any or all the following sanctions besides any administrative action such as (a) Imposition of liquidity damages; (b) Termination of contract for default; (c) Forfeiture of performance security.

- 15. **Extension of Time:** If the contract is delayed in the progress of work by changes ordered in the work, or any clause which BNPM shall decide to justify the delay, then the time of completion shall be extended by a reasonable time.

If at any time during the currency of contract, the successful bidder encounters conditions hindering timely completion of work, the successful bidder shall promptly inform BNPM in writing about the same and its likely duration and make a request to BNPM for extension of the completion schedule accordingly. On receiving the successful bidder's communication, BNPM shall examine the situation as soon as possible and, at its discretion, may agree to extend the completion schedule, with or without liquidated damages for completion of successful bidder's contractual obligations by issuing an amendment to the contract.

16. **Risk Purchase Clause:** If the successful bidder fails to abide by the terms and conditions of the agreement arising out of this enquiry (or) fails to supply the material/render work/execute the contract as per the completion schedule or any time repudiates the contract, the purchaser will have the right to,
- a) Procure the tender item/render work/ execute the work from other agencies at the risk and cost of the successful bidder. The cost difference between the alternative arrangement and existing contract value where the default has been made, will be recovered from the successful bidder along with the other incidental charges.
 - b) In case of procurement through alternative sources, if procurement price is lower than the existing contract value wherein default has been made, in such case no benefit on this account will be passed on to the successful bidder.
17. **Force Majeure:** In the event of any unforeseen event directly interfering with the execution of the contract arising during the currency of the contract, such as war, hostilities, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts, or acts of God, the Successful bidder shall, within a week from the commencement thereof, notify the same in writing to the Purchaser with reasonable evidence thereof. Unless otherwise directed by BNPM in writing, the successful bidder shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. If the force majeure condition(s) mentioned above be in force for a period of 90 days or more at any time, either successful bidder shall have the option to terminate the contract on expiry of 90 days of commencement of such force majeure by giving 14 days' notice to the other successful bidder in writing. In case of such termination, no damages shall be claimed by either successful bidder against the other, save and except those which had occurred under any other clause of this contract prior to such termination.
18. **Fore-Closure Clause:** If at any time during the continuation of this contract, the use of material ordered in this contract is completely banned or due to drastic change in Government policy its use as, raw material is discontinued or is declared hazardous to public health or cause rising to civil commotion, epidemics, wide-spread strikes and 21 days' notice of such eventualities is given by purchaser to the seller, the seller without any right to enforce the contract, will agree to the fore-close the performance of balance portion of this contract and in that event no claim for damages or loss will be lodged against the purchaser.
19. **Obligations by bidders:**
- i) All bidders are obliged under the CIPP (Code of integrity of public procurement) to suo moto proactively declare any conflict of interest (coming under the definition as mentioned in conflict-of-interest clause below, pre-existing or as and as soon as these arise at any stage) in any procurement process or execution of contract. Failure to do so would amount to violation of this Code of Integrity; and

- ii) Any bidder must declare, whether asked or not in a bid document, any previous transgressions of such a Code of Integrity with any entity in any country during the last 1 (One) year of being debarred by any other Procuring Entity. Failure to do so would amount to violation of this code of integrity.
20. **Conflict of Interest:** A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practice to the detriment of BNPM interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified after giving a reasonable opportunity of being heard. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:
- a. If its personnel have a close personal, financial, or business relationship with any personnel of the procuring entity who are directly or indirectly related to the procurement or execution process of the contract, which can affect the decision of the procuring entity directly or indirectly;
 - b. The bidder (or his allied firm as defined by DOE, MOF, GOI) provided services for the need assessment/procurement planning of the Tender process in which it is participating;
 - c. A Principal can authorize only one agent, and an agent should not represent or quote on behalf of more than one Principal. However, this shall not debar more than one Authorized distributor (with/ or without the OEM) from quoting equipment manufactured by an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) in procurements under Proprietary Article Certificate or
 - d. A bidder participates in more than one bid in this tender process. Participation in any capacity by a Bidder (including the participation of a Bidder as a partner/ JV member or sub-successful bidder in another bid or vice-versa) in more than one bid shall result in the disqualification of all bids in which he is a successful bidder. However, this does not limit the participation of an entity as a sub-successful bidder in more than one bid if he is not bidding independently in his own name or as a member of a JV.
21. Counter conditions (if any on technical & commercial terms) shall be reviewed by BNPM and acceptance of the same shall be at sole discretion of BNPM.
22. Bidders are advised to write the page number on each page of the Technical Bid documents submitted.
23. BNPM reserves the right to accept the offer by individual items and reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof and does not bind itself to accept lowest quotations.
24. **Divisibility & split-ability of contract:** This tender is non-divisible and non-split-able.
25. **Settlement of Disputes through Arbitration:** All disputes and differences of any kind whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the contract, whether during the progress of the work or after their completion except accepted matters shall be settled through arbitration process as per the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be Mysuru, Karnataka.
26. **Legal Jurisdiction:** The Courts of Mysuru (Karnataka State) shall alone have jurisdiction to decide on any legal matter of dispute whatsoever arising out or in respect of the contract.
27. **Rights of Rejection:** BNPMIPL reserves the right to reject any or all the applied bids without assigning any reason whatsoever. The enquiry can be rejected on national security grounds.
28. **Preference for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Make in India (MII):**

Works Contracts are not covered under the purview of Public Procurement Policy for MSEs, hence purchase preference is not applicable. Preference to MIs is not applicable.

29. **Note: JV/Consortium/ Sub Contracting are not allowed.**
30. **Site Inspection:** Any site information given in this tender document is for guidance only. The tenderer is advised to visit and examine all sites of works and its surroundings at their cost and obtain for them on their own responsibility, all information that may be necessary for preparing the tender and entering into a Contract. For visiting BNPM, Mysore plant prior permission is to be taken by prospective bidders from competent authority at BNPM, Mysore and to be visited via Email scm.tender@bnpmindia.com.
31. **Safety equipment:** The bidder should ensure that supervisor employed for supervising Installation & commissioning activity at the site is equipped with all the necessary safety gears and equipment required for carrying out the work safely. (List of safety equipment provided to the workmen to be submitted by the successful bidder before commencement of work at the site if sought by BNPM).
32. **Security and Confidentiality:** BNPM is a security organization and the premise is declared as 'Prohibited Area' by the Govt. of Karnataka. Hence the service provider has to abide by the security rules of the Company.
33. **Damage to Property:** Successful bidder shall supervise the installation, commissioning work and shall be responsible for making good to the satisfaction of the Purchaser any loss of and any damage to all structures and properties belonging to the Owner (BNPM) or being executed or procured by the Purchaser or of other agencies within the premises of the work of the Owner, if such loss or damage is due to fault and/or the negligence or wilful acts or omission of the Successful bidder, his employees, representatives. The Successful bidders shall indemnify and keep the Purchaser harmless of all claims for damage to Owner's property arising under or by reason of this contract.
34. **Employment liability towards personnel employed by the successful bidder** The Successful bidder shall be solely and exclusively responsible for engaging or employing persons (supervisor) for the execution of work. All persons engaged by the successful bidder shall be on Successful bidder's payroll and paid by Successful bidder. All disputes or differences between the Successful bidder and his/their employees shall be settled by Successful bidder.
BNPM has absolutely no liability whatsoever concerning the employees of the Successful bidder. The Successful bidder shall indemnify Purchaser against any loss or damage or liability arising out of or in the course of his/their employing persons or relation with his/their employees. The Successful bidder shall make regular and full payment of wages and on any complaint by any employee of the Successful bidder regarding non-payment of wages, salaries or other dues, Purchaser reserves the right to make payments directly to such employees of the Successful bidder and recover the amount in full from the bills of the Successful bidder and the successful bidder shall not claim any compensation or reimbursement thereof. The Successful bidder shall comply with the Minimum Wages Act applicable to the area of work site with regard to payment of wages to his employees.
The Successful bidder shall advise in writing or in such appropriate way to all of his employees that their appointment/employment is not by the Purchaser but by the Successful bidder and that

their present appointment is only in connection with the construction contract with Purchaser and that therefore, such an employment/appointment would not enable or make them eligible for any employment/appointment with the Purchaser either temporarily or/and permanent basis.

35. **Health & Safety Regulation** Successful bidder shall comply with the Health and Safety policy of the Company & should issue a certified photo-identity card to each of his employees employed for this contract and shall be authenticated by the designated security officer of BNPM. This photo-identity card should be shown to the security personnel at the entry. Due to obvious security reasons, the staff deployed by the successful bidder must adhere to all rules and regulations and security restrictions as prescribed by the BNPM from time to time.
36. **Insurance:** The Successful bidder shall provide ESIC/ Employee Compensation Insurance / Group insurance policy (as applicable) under which the person deputed will be covered, this should be to the satisfaction of the Owner as provided hereunder.
- a) The aforesaid insurance policy/policies shall provide that they shall not be cancelled till the Purchaser has agreed to their cancellation.
- b) The successful bidder shall satisfy to the Purchaser (BNPM) from time to time during the contract period that he has taken out all insurance policies referred to above and has paid the necessary premium for keeping the policies alive till the expiry of the defects liability period.
- c) The successful bidder shall ensure that similar insurance policies are taken out by his sub-successful bidder (if any) and shall be responsible for any claims or losses to the Purchaser resulting from their failure to obtain adequate insurance protections in connection thereof. The successful bidder shall produce or cause to be produced by his sub-successful bidder (if any) as the case may be, the relevant policy or policies and premium receipts as and when required by the Purchaser.
- d) The deployed personnel by successful bidder at BNPM. Mysore must be covered for ESI/Insurance for working at a height of 5 m.
37. **Labour and Labour Laws:** The successful bidder shall comply at its own cost with all prevailing statutory provisions such as minimum wages, PF, ESI/ Employees Compensation etc as laid down & as applicable under various Labour Laws and all other applicable statute as applicable & amended from time to time. In case of violation of such statutory provisions under the labour law by the agency, there will not be any liability on BNPM and the contract will be liable for termination.
38. **Model Rules for Labour Welfare**
The Successful bidder shall at his own expenses comply with Model rules for Labour Welfare as appended to those conditions or rules framed by the Government from time to time for the protection of health and for making sanitary arrangements for worker employed directly or indirectly on the works. In case the successful bidder fails to make arrangements as aforesaid the Purchaser shall be entitled to do so and recover the cost thereof from the successful bidder.
39. **Tax deduction at source** All statutory deduction as applicable shall be deducted at source as per rules at prevailing rates, unless certificate, if any, for deduction at lesser rate or nil deduction is submitted by the Successful bidder from appropriate authority. The successful bidder shall

provide accurate particulars of PAN number as required, under Section 206AA of Income Tax Act 1961.

40. **Payment of claims and damages:** a) Should the Purchaser have to pay money in respect of claims or demands against any damage caused by the successful bidder, the amount so paid and the costs incurred by the Purchaser shall be charged to and paid by the Successful bidder and the Successful bidder shall not be entitled to dispute or question the right of the Purchaser to make such payments notwithstanding the same may have been without his consent or authority or in law or otherwise to the contrary.
- b) In every case in which by virtue of the provisions of Employee's Compensation Act, or other Acts, the Purchaser is obliged to pay Compensation to a Workman employed by the Successful bidder in execution of the works, the Purchaser will recover from the Successful bidder the amount of compensation so paid and without prejudice to the rights of Purchaser under the said Act. Purchaser shall be at liberty to recover such amount or any part thereof by deducting it from the security.
- c) Deposit or from any sum due to the Successful bidder whether under this contract or otherwise. The Purchaser shall not be bound to contest any claim made under Section 12 sub section (1) of the said Act, except on the written request of the Successful bidder and upon his giving to the Purchaser full security for all costs for which the Purchaser might become liable in consequence of contesting such claim.

42. **Safety & Security Measures:**

- Removal of Old Refractory & Rebuild the Refractory for all the surfaces.
- Removal of old paint and repaint the entire incinerator including scrubber, chimney and ID fan.
- Straightening of the incinerator burning chamber's deformed surface plates.
- Supply and replacement of the top portion of the chimney along with rain hood.

Supply of Material: -

- While dispatching the material successful bidder should furnish the material test certificate with dispatch documents.
- Successful bidder shall depute his authorized representative at our site for the stacking of supplied material. BNPM will give space for stacking of material.

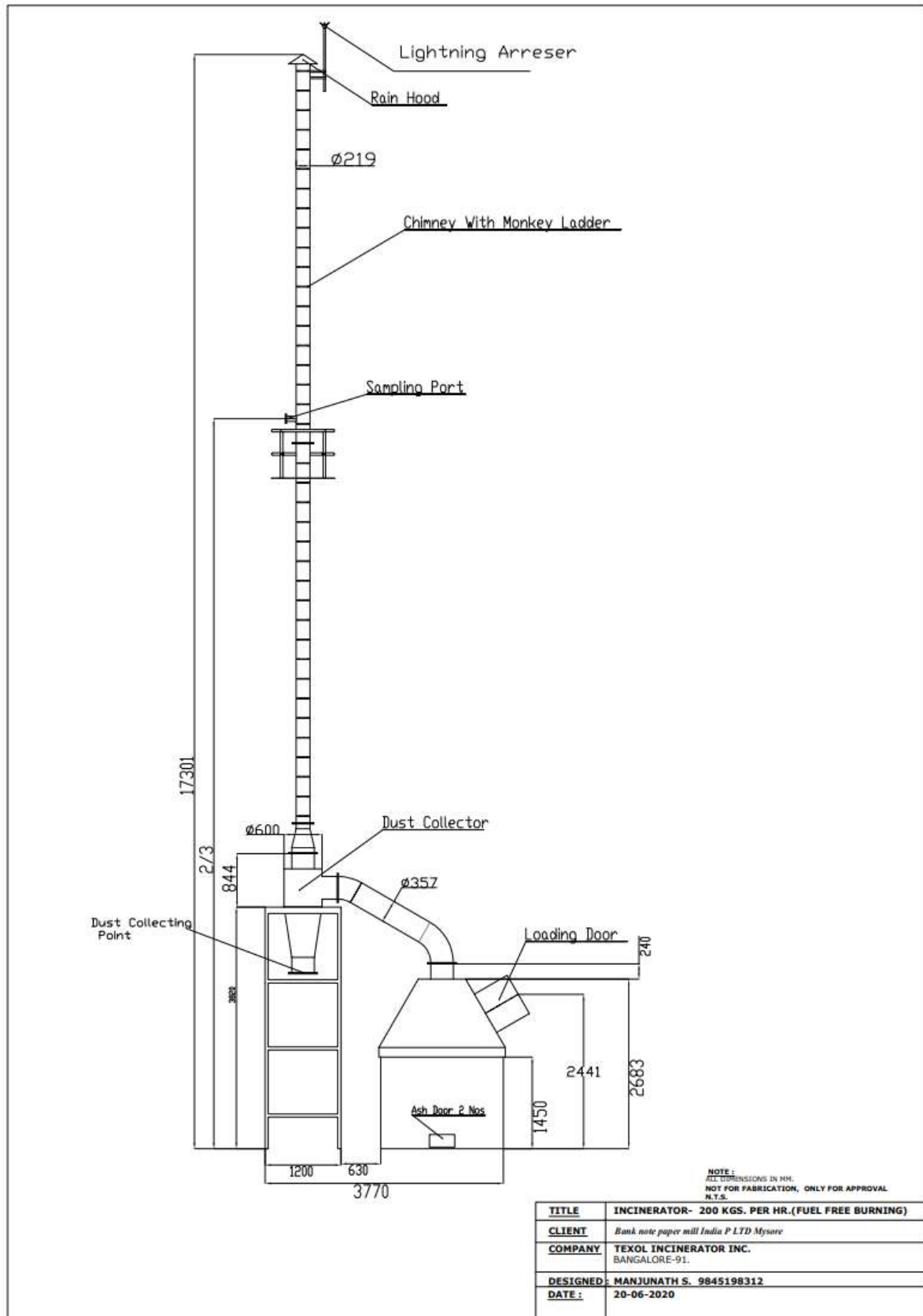
