Price shall be furnished through e-portal only.

Price offer submitted in any other format will be liable for rejection.

3. Payment terms:

100% payment shall be released within 30 days after successful completion of the work and duly certified by BNPM officials after submission of bill.

- **4. Work Schedule**: Successful contractor shall complete the work during specific date as promulgated by BNPM, Mysore.
- **5. Contract period validity:** The contract shall be valid for a period of Nine (09) months from the date of issue of work order.
- **6. Liquidated Damage:** In case your quotation is accepted and order is placed on you, the supply against the order should be made within the period stipulated in the order. BNPMIPL reserves the right to recover any loss sustained due to delayed delivery by way of penalty. Failure to supply the material within the stipulated period shall entitle BNPM to impose liquidated damages without assigning any reasons @ 0.5% (Half Percent) of the total value of the item covered in order as LD per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% (Ten Percent) which you unconditionally and expressly agree to unless extension is obtained in writing from the office on valid ground before expiry of delivery period.

Price quoted should be net and valid for a minimum period of three months from the date of opening of the quotation.

14. Evaluation Criteria:

- The technical bids shall be opened in the first instance and these bids shall be 5scrutinized and evaluated by the competent committee/ authority with reference to the parameters prescribed in the tender document. Subsequently, in the second stage the financial bids of only technically acceptable offers as decided in first stage shall be opened for further scrutiny and evaluation. Intimation regarding opening of financial bids shall be given to acceptable tenderers to enable them to attend the financial bid opening, if they so desire.
- ii) **Method of Evaluation**: Evaluation shall be carried out on **total effective price** quoted by the bidders, unless any other method of evaluation is specifically provided in the enquiry and contract shall be awarded to **overall lowest (L-1) bidder**. The quoted price should be inclusive of P&F, Freight, Transit Insurance and any other charges required for delivery of item to BNPM, Mysuru on F.O.R basis.
- iii) All responsive tenderers shall be evaluated as per the terms & conditions of the tender. The basis for arriving at the lowest responsive bidder shall be as per the price quoted for landed cost at Mysore including GST, packing & forwarding charges, freight, insurance and any other charges etc. and input credit shall be deducted to arrive at the effective price. Effective price shall be considered for arriving the lowest responsive bidder.
- iv) Bidder has to quote GST rate as per the HSN code provided in Section XI: Price Schedule. In case of any mismatch in HSN code with respect to offered product, same shall be decided in consultation with winning bidder.
- v) All tenderers should be registered under GST. They should be eligible to pass on input credit. Bid will be evaluated all-inclusive though input credit will be deducted to arrive at the effective cost.

- **15.** Payment of GST is primarily the responsibility of the seller and will not be paid unless the percentage value is clearly mentioned in the quotations. If no indication regarding GST is recorded in the quotation, the GST will be considered as included.
- **16.** If the supplier fails to abide by the terms and conditions of the agreement arising out of this enquiry (or) fails to supply the material/service as per the delivery schedule or any time repudiates the contract, the purchaser will have the right to,
 - a) Procure the tender item/render service from other agencies at the risk and cost of the supplier. The cost difference between the alternative arrangement and existing contract value where the default has been made, will be recovered from the supplier along with the other incidental charges.
 - b) In case of procurement through alternative sources, if procurement price is lower than the existing contract value wherein default has been made, in such case no benefit on this account will be passed on to the supplier.
- **17. Risk Purchase Clause**: If the supplier fails to abide by the terms and conditions of this agreement, or fails to supply the material / service as per the delivery schedule or any time repudiates the contract, the purchaser will have the right to
 - a. Procure the tender item / render service from other agencies at the risk and cost of the supplier.
 - b. The cost difference between the alternative arrangement and existing contract value wherein default has been made will be recovered from the supplier along with the other incidental charges.
 - In case of procurement through alternative sources, if procurement price is lower than the existing contract value wherein default has been made, in such case no benefit on this account will be passed on to the supplier.
- **18. Settlement of Disputes through Arbitration:** All disputes and differences of any kind whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the contract, whether during the progress of the work or after their completion except accepted matters shall be settled through arbitration process as per the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be Mysore, Karnataka
- **19. Legal Jurisdiction:** The Courts of Mysore (Karnataka State) shall alone have jurisdiction to decide on any legal matter of dispute whatsoever arising out or in respect of the contract.
- **20. Force Majeure:** In the event of any unforeseen event directly interfering with the supply of stores arising during the currency of the contract, such as war, hostilities, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts, or acts of God, the Contractor shall, within a week from the commencement thereof, notify the same in writing to the Purchaser with reasonable evidence thereof. Unless otherwise directed by BNPM in writing, the supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as reasonably practical, and



shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. If the force majeure condition(s) mentioned above be in force for a period of 90 days or more at any time, either party shall have the option to terminate the contract on expiry of 90 days of commencement of such force majeure by giving 14 days' notice to the other party in writing. In case of such termination, no damages shall be claimed by either party against the other, save and except those which had occurred under any other clause of this contract prior to such termination.

- **21. Fore-Closure Clause:** If at any time during the continuation of this contract, the use of material ordered in this contract is completely banned or due to drastic change in Government policy its use as, raw material is discontinued or is declared hazardous to public health or cause rising to civil commotion, epidemics, wide-spread strikes and 21 days' notice of such eventualities is given by purchaser to the seller, the seller without any right to enforce the contract, will agree to the fore-close the performance of balance portion of this contract and in that event no claim for damages or loss will be lodged against the purchaser.
- **22.** As on the date of submission of bid against this tender, bidder should not be in the list of ineligible/ blacklisted/ banned/ debarred entity by SPMCIL/ BRBNMPL/ BNPMIPL/any Government Agency for participating in its tenders.
- **23.** Bidder may visit BNPMIPL, before submitting the offer after taking due permission for visiting to understand the requirements.
- **24.** Counter conditions (if any), will be subject to review and acceptance of BNPM. In case of non-acceptance of counter conditions by BNPM, bid shall be liable to be rejected/ignored.
- **25.** Bidders are advised to write the page number on each page of the Technical Bid documents submitted.
- **26.** The BNPMIPL reserves the right to accept the offer by individual items and reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof and does not bind itself to accept lowest quotations.

27. Service Delivery:

It is responsibility of the successful bidder to arrange manpower services at BNPM, Mysore accordingly. The necessary transportation arrangement for manpower should be provided by the contractor.

If the service conditions as per the Contract are not met, the Contractor will be blacklisted and will not be considered for any future proposals.

28. Labour and Labour Laws

The successful bidder shall comply at its own cost with all prevailing statutory provisions as laid down & as applicable under various Labour Laws like- Minimum Wages Act, VDA, Provident Fund & Misc. Provisions Act, ESI,(contractor should have valid PF, ESI Registration) Bonus Act, Gratuity Act, Contract Labour Act (Regulation & Abolition), Workmen Compensation Act, Factories Act, Bonus Act, Industrial Dispute Act, Payment of



wages Act and all other applicable statute as applicable & amended from time to time. In case of violation of such statutory provisions under the labour law by the agency, there will not be any liability on BNPM and the contract will be liable for termination.

The successful bidder will have to obtain the valid licence (as & if applicable) under the Contract. Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act – 1970 with Contract labour (R&A) Rules – 1971 from the appropriate authority and will have to submit the certified Xerox copy of the same to the BNPM. They have to abide by the rules made thereunder the Act.

The successful bidder has to meet and ensure all statutory liabilities such as PF, ESI, Retrenchment benefit, Leave Encashment etc. towards his workers. In addition to above, the successful bidder has to pay the amount, if any, required to be paid to these labourers as and when ordered by Labour Authorities / Court pertaining to the tenure of this contract.

29. Model Rules for Labour Welfare

The Successful bidder shall at his own expenses comply with Model rules for Labour Welfare as appended to those conditions or rules framed by the Government from time to time for the protection of health and for making sanitary arrangements for worker employed directly or indirectly on the works. In case the successful bidder fails to make arrangements as aforesaid the Purchaser shall be entitled to do so and recover the cost thereof from the successful bidder.

30.Insurance

The successful bidder shall provide ESIC/ Employee Compensation Insurance (covering the required height at which the work is to be carried out)/ Group insurance policy (as applicable) under which the person deputed will be covered, this should be to the satisfaction of the Owner as provided hereunder.

- a) The aforesaid insurance policy/policies shall provide that they shall not be cancelled till the Purchaser has agreed to their cancellation.
- b) The successful bidder shall satisfy to the Purchaser from time to time that he has taken out all insurance policies referred to above and has paid the necessary premium for keeping the policies alive till the expiry of the defects liability period.
- c) The successful bidder shall ensure that similar insurance policies are taken out by his sub-contractor (if any) and shall be responsible for any claims or losses to the Purchaser resulting from their failure to obtain adequate insurance protections in connection thereof. The contractor shall produce or cause to be proceed by his sub-contractor (if any) as the case may be, the relevant policy or policies and premium receipts as and when required by the Purchaser.
- d) The deployed personnel by successful bidder at BNPM. Mysore must be covered for ESI/Insurance.
- **31. Rights of Rejection:** BNPMIPL reserves the right to reject any or all the applied bids without assigning any reason whatsoever. The enquiry can be rejected on national security grounds.



- II) "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this order means:
 - a) An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - b) A subsidiary controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country, or
 - c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country, or
 - d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
 - e) An India (or other) agent of such an entity; or
 - f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
 - g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above.
- III) The beneficial owner for the purpose of (iii) above will be as under :-
- 1) In case of a company or limited liability partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person (s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more judicial person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercise control through other means.

Further explanation:
